PROSECUTOR for the Respondent, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

The Criminal Petition, under Sections 437 and 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioner/A-1 seeking to grant bail in connection with Crime No. 68 of 2020 of Yellandu Police Station, Bhadradi Kothagudem District which was registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120 (b), 143, 148 and 307 read with Section 149 of I.P.C.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent-State and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been in custody since 17.04.2020. He further submits that the other accused have already been released on bail. He also submits that the petitioner is innocent; that he did not commit any offence as alleged in the complaint. The petitioner is ready to abide by any condition that may be imposed by this Court in the event of his enlargement on bail.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the *de facto* complainant has received injuries on right leg and right hand, but he has not been examined by the doctor. Hence, there is no medical report on record.

Looking into the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner; having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the fact that the petitioner/A-1 is in judicial custody since 17.04.2020, without adverting to the merits of the case, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/A-1.

The Criminal Petition is allowed and the petitioner/A-1 is directed to be released on bail, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (i) The petitioner/A-1 shall be released on bail on his executing a personal bond to the tune of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only) with two sureties to the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Yellandu.
- (ii) The petitioner/A-1 shall not interfere with the investigation, intimidate or induce the material witnesses and shall cooperate with the investigating agency.
- (iii) The petitioner/A-1 shall not misuse the liberty granted to him.
