ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader for Revenue for the respondents. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission.

This writ petition is filed questioning the inaction of the respondents in considering the application of the petitioners dated 23.07.2019 for assignment of Government land in Survey No.613 situated at Cheerlavancha Village, Thangaliapally Mandal, Rajanna Sircilla Mandal, in their favour.

The learned counsel for the petitioners states that though the petitioners have made an application to the concerned officials on 23.07.2019 for assigning the Government land in their favour, no orders are passed thereon till date. Hence, he seeks a direction to the official respondents to consider the application of the petitioners and pass necessary orders thereon, at the earliest.

The learned Government Pleader for Revenue, on instructions, states that due to the present pandemic situation and the subsequent lockdown, the application made by the petitioners on 23,07,2019 could not be considered, and seeks some time for passing necessary orders on the said application.

In view of the above submission, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the official respondents to consider the application made by the petitioners on 23.07.2019 and pass necessary orders thereon, strictly in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is needless to mention that the official respondents before passing any orders shall put the petitioners as well as any other interested persons on notice and give them an opportunity of hearing. A copy of the order passed by the officials respondents will be communicated to the parties.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
