Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue it a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS directing the respondents 1 to 3 to provide electricity connection to the ground floor 2600 sft carpet area and first floor 2600 sqft carpet area of the building premises No.3-6-630 along with 6 car parkings in cellar together with open area in front of the building per parking purpose of premises No.3-6-630 situated at ward No.3 block No.6 Himayathnagar Hyderabad bounded by North neighbours property South road East neighbours property West road and neighbours property. Without insisting upon occupancy Certificate from the 4th respondent by holding that the refusal to provide electricity connection to the above referred premises as illegal and arbitrary.

The Court made the following: ORDER

WRIT PETITION No.14177 OF 2020

ORAL ORDER:

This writ petition is being disposed of at the admission stage with the consent of both parties.

2. When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue raised in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the order dated 17.08.2020 passed by this Court in W.P. No.12591 of 2020.

3. Mr. R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Southern Power Distribution Company Limited appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Mr. Pasham Krishna Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation appearing on behalf of respondent No.4, do not dispute the aforesaid submission.

4. In view of the above, for the reasons alike in the said order, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release power supply to the premises of the petitioner subject to the compliance of terms and conditions and on furnishing an undertaking to produce occupancy certificate from the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) within a period of six (06) months, and if no such occupancy certificate is produced within such period, it is open to the respondents to take appropriate action in accordance with law. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in the main writ petition shall stand closed.
