Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not receiving the application form and not releasing the power supply to the petitioner House Bearing Flat No.501 in Fifth Floor, admeasuring 585 sq Feet, including common area and one car parking, together with undivided share of land 12.50 sq yards out of 300 sq yards, in H.No.2-56/11 Part, in Sy.No.11/27, situated at Lambadi Tanda, Khanamet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Range Reddy District as illegal, null, void, arbitrary and consequently direct the respondents to release the power supply without being influenced by the instructions of the 5th respondent.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents 1 to 4 to receive the application form and release the power supply to the petitioner House Bearing Flat No.501 in Fifth Floor, admeasuring 585 sq Feet, including common area and one car parking, together with undivided share of land

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri R.Vinod Reddy, learned Standing counsel for Telangana State Southern Power Supply Distribution Company Limited, appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 4, and Sri Sampath Prabhakar Reddy, learned Standing counsel appearing for respondent No.5. With their consent, the Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the *lis* in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the order passed this Court in W.P.No.22849 of 2018, dated 05.07.2018, W.P.21100 of 2019, dated 25.09.2019, and W.P.No.7997 of 2020, dated 11.06.2020.

The above said submission is not disputed by the learned Standing Counsels appearing for the respondents herein.

In view of the same and for the reasons alike in the orders referred to above, the present Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release individual service connection to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, and the same shall be subject to further directions that may be issued by the State of Telangana or the Apex Court in the litigation pending before it arising out of the order, dated 12.09.2012, in W.P.No.20407 of 2008 & batch.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

2. The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation represented by its Commissioner is *suo motu* impleaded as a party respondent in the Writ Petition.

3. It is stated by counsel on either side that the issue in this Writ Petition is covered by the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.32614 of 2015 dt.18.12.2015.

4. Therefore, for reasons alike, this Writ Petition is also disposed of directing the respondents to release new service connections to the petitioners on payment of requisite charges by the petitioners within a period of four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, which shall be subject to the further directions which may be issued by the State Government of Telangana or the Supreme Court, which is considering the judgment dt.12.09.2012 of Division Bench of this Court in W.P.No.20407 of 2008 and batch.
