Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the impugned Memo No.A11/430/2016, dt.05.09.2017 issued by the 3rd Respondent as arbitrary, discriminatory, illegal and contrary to the scheme of compassionate appointment and consequently direct the Respondents to forthwith permit the Petitioner to join duty as Typist, as per appointment on compassionate grounds made vide Memo No.A2/707/2015-1, dt.04.01.2017, with notional benefits, from the date of the said appointment order dt.04.01.2017, and with all other consequential benefits, monetary or otherwise.
