Through the instant petition under Section 438(1) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.185 dated 07.12.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 323, 427, 149,506 and 451 IPC at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Vide order dated 17.07.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhmander Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
