Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-4) dated 28.12.2020, in this regard, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Petitioner No.1 has placed on record copy of her Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record copy of Voter card (Annexure P-2) as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P-3).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Station House Officer, Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, Punjab to look into the representation Annexure P-4 dated 28.12.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
