Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing/setting aside of the order dated 12.03.2018, whereby the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender in FIR No.114 dated 23.06.2016 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC registered at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated October 17, 2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. Even otherwise, the matter has been compromised between the parties and the aforesaid FIR has been quashed by this Court qua the petitioner vide order of

even date passed in *CRM-M-44600 of 2019* titled as *Lovepreet Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*. In this manner, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
