The case is taken up through video conferencing.

There is no representation for the petitioner.

Dr. K.H. Gupta, Advocate for respondent nos. 1 to 3.

Mr. Vinod Nautiyal, Deputy Advocate General for the State of Uttarakhand.

By means of this writ petition, petitioner has sought following relief:

"(i) Issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent no. 1 to 3 to accept the examination forms first semester of students of Petitioner's College admitted under the NRI quota for B.Ed. course of session 2017-2019, which are not being accepted without any rhyme and reason and the examination of the students of first semester is scheduled in the first week of February inspite of the fact that Petitioner has deposited the entire examination of fees of these seven students and have admitted them by following the due process as directed by the University."

In sum & substance, petitioner wanted permission to its students for appearing in the examination conducted by H.N.B. Garhwal University.

This Court, vide order dated 24.01.2018, had granted such permission.

In such view of the matter, the relief, as claimed in the writ petition, does not survive.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
