The present applicant is an accused in FIR No. 649 of 2012, where he is facing trial under Section 147, 148, 149, 302, 307, 120B/34 of IPC, registered at Police Station – Kashipur, District – Udham Singh Nagar.

His regular bail applications have been rejected by this Court.

This is 9<sup>th</sup> Short Term Bail Application by the applicant. Earlier twice he has been granted short term bail by this Court vide order dated 18.06.2018 and 6.11.2019 for a period of one month each. He has now prayed for short term on ground that her mother is paralytic and she needs medical care.

The short term bail application is being objected by the State on ground that the trial is at the fag end. All the prosecution witnesses have been examined. There are prosecution witnesses, which include eye witness and particularly at this fag end of trial, short term bail could not be granted.

Considering the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, where the only ground taken by the applicant is that his mother is paralytic and she needs care, this Court is not inclined to release the applicant on short term bail for reasons that the trial is at the fag end and twice earlier he has been granted short term bail by this Court for the same reasons.

Consequently, short term bail application is rejected.
