Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public  
Prosecutor through Video Conferencing.

This bail application has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.  
in connection with FIR No. 0099/2019 registered at Police Station  
Neemrana, District Alwar for the offence(s) under Sections 420,  
406, 506 & 120B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has  
been lodged with an intention to harass the accused petitioner and  
no recovery has been made from the possession of the accused  
petitioner. After investigation, challan has been filed. The accused  
petitioner is behind the bars since 29.11.2019. The conclusion of  
trial may take a long time and requested the bail application of the  
petitioner be granted.

Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application and submits that as per order dated 11.02.2020 passed by the learned trial Court a criminal case has been pending against the accused petitioner.

Looking to the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the allegation against the petitioner is under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 120B IPC, but without expressing any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Samundra Singh S/o Shri Narayan Singh** shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
