This bail application has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 CrPC seeking regular bail in FIR No. 73/2017 registered at Police Station, Gegal, District Ajmer for the offence under Sections 143, 379, 511, 323, 341 IPC (but the offence found to have been made out under Sections 143, 341, 323, 307 IPC).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the co-accused Bhawani Singh and Hari Singh have been enlarged on bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.4.2017 in S.B. Cr. Misc. IInd Bail Application No. 9702/2017. He further submits that injury no. 4 has been attributed to co-accused Sher Singh, who has been enlarged on bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.7.2017 in S.B.

Cr. Misc. IInd Bail Application NO. 9703/2017. He further submits that no recovery has been affected from the petitioner. The petitioner is in judicial custody since long and the conclusion of trial is likely to take long time, hence he may be enlarged on bail.

Learned PP appearing for the State has opposed the same.

Considering the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the case, but without expressing any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Therefore, this bail application is allowed and accused petitioner Kalyan Singh S/o Sura Singh is ordered to be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each before the trial court, subject to its satisfaction, with the stipulation that the petitioner shall appear before that court on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
