Lawyers are abstaining from work in view of the unprecedented situation being faced by the country due to pandemic of novel corona virus (COVID-19).

Mr. N.K. Gurjar, learned counsel, who is present in the Court, has filled in the memo of appearance today in the Court itself. Therefore, the office objection is overruled.

The present bail application has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner who is in custody in connection with F.I.R. No. 41/2020, Police Station Kotwali, Jalore for the offences under Sections 457, 380, 436, 465, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B of I.P.C.

I have gone through the order impugned, pleadings in the bail application as well as written submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner received through email.

Mr. Farzand Ali, learned Additional Advocate General – cum – Government Counsel opposes the bail application.

Having regard to the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case as also the present situation of the country due to pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19), in particular the jails, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the present bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner - **Bhanwarlal S/o Mohanlal** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 41/2020, Police Station Kotwali, Jalore shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees: Fifty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees : Twenty Five Thousand Only) each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
