Lawyers are abstaining from work in view of the unprecedented situation being faced by the country due to pandemic of novel corona virus (COVID-19).

The present second bail application has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioners who are in custody in connection with F.I.R. No. 32/2020, Police Station Devnagar, District Jodhpur for the offences under Section 8/21 and 29 of the NDPS Act.

I have gone through the order impugned as well as pleadings in the bail application.

After rejection of the first bail application of the petitioners by this Court vide Order dated 14/02/2020, the charge-sheet in the case has been filed.

Mr. Farzand Ali, learned Additional Advocate General Cum Govt. Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent State opposes the bail application.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and upon a consideration of the pleadings in the bail application and considering the peculiar circumstances prevailing in the country due to the pandemic of COVID-19, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioners are entitled for grant of bail under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.

Consequently, the present second bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioners – **(1) Mahendra S/o Shri Kantilal & (2) Naru Meena S/o Shri Bhera Ji Meena** arrested in connection with F.I.R. No. 32/2020, Police Station Devnagar, District Jodhpur shall be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees: One Lac Only) with two sureties of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees : Fifty Thousand Only) each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
