In compliance with the *rule nisi* issued on 19.10.2020, Smt. Neetu Yadav, the detenue-petitioner, has been produced by Lady Constable Soni (L/C - 3131), who has identified the detenue before this Court. This Court, accordingly, proceeds to ascertain her stand, which is recorded *verbatim* :-

**Q. Aapka naam?**

**A.** Neetu Yadav.

**Q. Aapke pitaji ka naam?**

**A.** Nem Singh Yadav.

**Q. Aapki aayu?**

**A.** 16 saal.

**Q. Aap kahan se aayi hain?**

**A.** Papa ke ghar se.

**Q. Ye Raj Kumar kaun hai?**

**A.** Mera ussey koi sambandh nahi hai.

**Q. Kya aap apne pijaji ke saath apni marzi se hain?**

**A.** Haa.

**Q. Aapke saath kisi ne koi zor-zabardasti toh nahi ki?**

**A.** Nahi.

Heard Sri G.R. Yadav, Advocate holding brief of Sri Preet Pal

Singh Rathore, learned counsel for the petitioners, Sri Amar Bahadur Maurya, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no. 4 and Sri Indrajit Singh, learned A.G.A. appearing on behalf of the State.

The stand of the detenue is clear, which shows that she is not in illegal confinement of the fourth respondent.

In this view of the matter, there is no good ground to make the *rule nisi* dated 19.10.2020, absolute. The rule is, therefore, discharged.

In the result, the writ petition fails and stands **dismissed**.

The sum of Rs. 15,000/- deposited with Registrar General by the petitioner shall be remitted in the appropriate head of account of the State Government, **forthwith**.
