The petitioner, who is a constable in Civil Police, has challenged his order of

transfer dated 17.1.2020. By the said order, the petitioner has been transferred

from Mahoba to Chitrakoot. The order recites that the transfer was made in

public interest and had due approval of the Police Establishment Board. In

pursuance thereof, the Superintendent of Police, Mahoba passed an order on

18.1.2020 by which the petitioner was relieved from charge at Mahoba with

direction to report at the transferred place.

Although, the writ petition was filed on 4.3.2020 but it seems that it has not been

pressed so far despite several dates having been fixed from time to time.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the transfer order passed in mid session

is contrary to government policy contained in various government orders issued

from time to time.

The policy contained in government order is directive in nature and breach

thereof is not subject to judicial review. The petitioner has remedy of

approaching the higher authorities complaining the breach. Apart from it, this

Court, at this distance of time, does not consider it appropriate to examine the

validity of the impugned transfer order which on the face of it does not suffer

from any manifest error. The petition is accordingly dismissed with liberty

reserved in favour of the petitioner to approach the departmental authorities with

his grievance, if so advised.
