This bail matter has been taken up for out of turn hearing as the petitioner stated in the mentioning slip supported with medical report that he is a patient HIV positive.

Let the defect(s) be removed within two weeks of start of normal functioning of the court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 302, 326 of the I.P.C.

For land dispute the petitioner and co-accused Shatrughan Singh allegedly assaulted with bhala to two persons. There is no allegation against the petitioner of commission of assault to the deceased. Petitioner is in custody since



26.03.2021.

Considering the nature of allegation and fact that the petitioner is HIV positive and investigation of the case is already complete, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Parsa P.S. Case No. 97 of 2017, with following conditions:

- (a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.
- (b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
- (c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
