Sanjay Kumar (C.J.):

Mr. Y. Nirmolchand, learned senior counsel, appears for the respondents/writ petitioners.

The Manipur State Power Distribution Company Limited seeks condonation of the delay of 250 days in filing an appeal against the order dated 26.08.2019 passed by a learned Judge of this Court in W.P. (C) No. 832 of 2017. By the said order, the learned Judge directed the applicants/appellants to settle the bill amount of .6,54,900/- payable to the writ petitioners, along with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of the supply of the materials.

Though the matter is still pending consideration upon the aforestated condone delay application, Mr. N. Kumarjit, learned Advocate General, Manipur, would inform this Court that the Government of Manipur was pleased to accord administrative approval for payment of a sum of . 6,54,900/- (Rupees Six Lakh Fifty Four Thousand Nine Hundred) only, to the respondents/writ petitioners in compliance with the aforestated order dated 26.08.2019 passed in W.P. (C) No.

832 of 2017. A copy of the order dated 22.10.2021 passed by the Commissioner (Power), Government of Manipur, stating to this effect is placed on record.

In the light of this development, Mr. N. Kumarjit, learned Advocate General, Manipur, states that the applicants/appellants do not wish to pursue this matter.

Recording the said statement, the condone delay application is dismissed as infructuous.

In consequence, the unnumbered writ appeal shall stand rejected.

In the circumstances, there shall be no order as to costs.
