- 1. Having heard learned counsel for the respective parties, I deem it convenient to dispose of this petition by directing respondent No. 5, Deputy Commissioner, West Khasi Hills District, Nongstoin, Meghalaya to decide the petitioner's representation dated 14-01-2021, copy of which is annexed at page 46 of the petition, as expeditiously as possible and in any case within the period of four weeks from the date of the order. Ordered accordingly.
- 2. It is made clear that respondent No. 5 shall decide the said representation independently on its own merit and in accordance with law. Needless to mention that respondent No. 5 shall dispose of the said representation by passing a speaking order after following principles of natural justice.
- 3. It is specifically made clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter and all points and contentions of the respective parties are kept open to be agitated before respondent No. 5. In the event any order adverse to the interest of the petitioner by the respondent No. 5, petitioner is at liberty to avail appropriate remedy including writ petition in the High Court.
- 4. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
