ORDER 29.01.2021

The present appeal has been filed by the appellant against the award dated 14.05.2013 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jammu in File No. 83/Claim titled Sandhya Updhyay and ors. Vs. Gurdev Singh and ors.

During the course of hearing, both the counsels appearing for the appellant as well as respondent Nos. 1 to 6, have mutually agreed that only the interest part of the award passed by the learned Tribunal is required to be reduced from 7.5% per annum to 6% per annum and the basic amount shall remain the same. Statement made by both the counsels is taken on record.

In view of the above, the award dated 14.05.2013 is modified to the extent that the rate of interest payable by the appellant-insurance company shall be at the rate of 6 % per annum till the liquidation of the whole amount.

Mr. Gupta submits that whole award amount along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum stands deposited by the appellant before this Court. In view of this, the award amount shall be released in favour of the claimants i.e. respondent Nos. 1 to 6 after due verification along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum in terms of award and the remaining amount, if any, shall be reimbursed to the appellant insurance company.

The appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
