While the informant and Urmila Kunwar were returning from Daltonganj on a motorcycle they were waylaid by miscreants and were divested off mobile, cash of Rs. 1000/-, ATM Card etc.

The petitioner is not named in the First Information Report and seems to have been implicated on the confession of co-accused Vivek Kumar. It has been stated in this application that no Test Identification Parade has been held. The petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2020.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Palamau at Daltonganj in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No. 330/2020.
