The petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail, as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kathikund P.S. Case No. 55 of 2020, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1224/2020.

One person was apprehended while he was trying to trespass into the house of the informant.

The petitioner seems to have been implicated on the disclosure made by apprehended accused Mohan Das Besra. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent as stated in this application.

Regard being had to the above, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks and on his surrender, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dumka in connection with Kathikund P.S. Case No. 55 of 2020, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1224/2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This application stands allowed.
