The matter was taken up through Video Conferencing. Learned counsel for the parties had no objection with it and submitted that the audio and video qualities are good.

03/28.05.2021 Apprehending their arrest, the petitioners have moved this Court for grant of privilege of anticipatory bail in connection with Jasidih P.S. Case No. 227 of 2020 for the offence under Sections 188/413/414/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 21 of MMDR Act and Section 54 of JMMC Rule, 2004 and is pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that these petitioners are drivers and sand loaded trucks have been seized. It has been alleged that sand was being illegally transported. It has been further submitted that owner of the trucks namely Laxman Choudhary has already been granted anticipatory bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in A. B.A. No. 4875 of 2020 vide order dated 12.10.2020.

Learned A. P. P. has opposed the prayer.

Considering the material available on records and the fact that owner of the trucks has already been granted anticipatory bail, the petitioners are granted privilege of anticipatory bail. Hence, in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from the date of this order, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Deoghar, in connection with Jasidih P.S. Case No. 227 of 2020 subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. and also subject to the condition that the petitioners shall show receipt of payment of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand) each in favour of the Advocate Clerks' Association, Jharkhand High Court, Ranchi, before the learned court below prior to their release.
