03. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.  
2 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.  
3. The petitioner being in custody in C.T. Case No.15 of 2019 arising out of Bijepur P.S. Case No.201 of 2018 pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Padampur, has filed this petition for her release on bail. The offence alleged against the petitioner is punishable under Sections 450/307/302/34/120-B IPC.  
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press this BLAPL but a direction may be given to the trial court to expedite the trial.  
5. In view of such submission, this BLAPL stands disposed of as withdrawn. The trial court is directed to expedite the trial of the aforesaid case and conclude the same within six months after resumption of the normal court work.
