- 1. Heard Mr. B.P.Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. D.Mohanty, learned Additional Government Advocate for the State-Opposite Parties.
- 2. The Petitioner has filed this writ petition challenging fixation of monthly MGQ of IMFL and Beer in his license for the year 2020-21 and seek for a direction to the Opposite Party No.1 to take a decision on his application dated 12th February, 2021(Annexure-3) for exemption in lifting of quantity of IMFL and Beer and reduction of consideration money and lifting of IMFL and Beer as per demand of the consumer may be treated as monthly MGQ of the shops till Covid -19 situation.
- 3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that highlighting the grievance, the Petitioner has made representation to Opposite Party No.1 vide Annexure-3, but no decision has yet been taken.
- 4. Considering the limited grievance of the Petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court disposes of the writ petition directing Oppostie Party No.1 to take a decision on the representation filed by the Petitioner vide Annexure-3 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law by affording opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner within

a period of four weeks from the date of production of certified/authenticated copy of this order.

- 5. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
- 6. An urgent certified copy of this order be issued as per rules.
