This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical Mode).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application for bail under section 439 of Cr.P.C. in connection with Khurda Sadar P.S.Case No. 0163 of 2020 corresponding to T.R. Case No. 46 of 2020 pending in the Court of learned Special Judge –cum- 1st Addl. Sessions Judge, Khurda for alleged commission of offence under section 21(c) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The prayer for bail of the petitioner has been rejected by the learned Special Judge under NDPS Act, Khurda by order dated 30.09.2020.

In view of the nature of accusation that commercial quantity of ganja has been seized from the possession of the petitioner, who was a pillion rider and the bar under section 37 of the N.D.P.S. Act, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail. However, the petitioner is at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after examination of the material witnesses in the trial Court.

The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
