## 1 THE HIGH COURT OF MADHYA PRADESH M.Cr.C. No.41573/2021 Amit Singh Raghav vs. State of M.P.

This application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed for extension of period of temporary parole granted to the applicant by order dated 7.5.2021 passed in M.Cr.C.No.22562/2021 mainly on the ground that his wife is pregnant.

The applicant is facing trial for offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, under Section 3/6 of M.P. Nikshepakon Ke Hito Ka Sanrakshan Adhiniyam, under Section 45(A), 45(S), 58(B), 5A of R.B.I. Adhiniyam and under Sections 4, 5, 6 of Nikshepak Adhiniyam.

By order dated 7.5.2021 passed in M.Cr.C. No.22562/2021, the applicant was granted temporary parole for a period of four months. It appears that during this period of interim bail which is in the form of parole, the wife of the applicant conceived. This Court is of the considered opinion that the applicant cannot take advantage of his own act. Accordingly, no case is made out for extension of period of temporary bail/parole.
