(HEERA SINGH MARKO Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH AND OTHERS)

Petitioner has filed this petition challenging transfer order dated 06.08.2021, by which he has been transferred from Primary School Dogaritola to Primary School, Mitthumahua, District Anuppur.

It is submitted by the counsel appearing for petitioner that distance between the two schools is 86 kms. Petitioner's mother is bed ridden and unable to walk. In these circumstances, he is required to take care of his mother. If he has to go to transferred place then he will not be able to attend his mother. Counsel for the petitioner further submitted that no other person has been transferred in petitioner's place. It is further submitted that petitioner has filed a representation, but, the same has not been considered and decided. He makes a limited prayer that respondent authorities be directed to consider and decide his representation.

Counsel appearing for the State submitted that representation preferred by the petitioner shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

Heard the counsel for the parties.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, writ petition filed by the petitioner is disposed off with direction to respondent No.4 to consider and decide the representation of petitioner by passing a reasonable and speaking order.

Till decision on representation, *status quo* may be maintained in in respect of service condition of the petitioner.

No opinion is expressed on the merits of the case.

With aforesaid direction, writ petition is **disposed off**.
