

# The High Court Of Madhya Pradesh

MCRC No. 56274 of 2021

(PREMSHANKAR BHARDWAJ Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH)

This is first bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. on behalf of applicant, who is in jail since 03.10.2021 in connection with Crime No.186/2021, registered at Police Station Industrial Area Satlapur District - Raisen (M.P.), for the offences punishable under Sections 376, 342 & 506 of IPC.

Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that applicant has falsely been implicated in the case, prosecutrix is liar and she also got registered cases of rape against other persons, two of such cases are known to the applicant. It is submitted that she wants to extort money from the applicant and when he did not give her money, he has filed false FIR against him. It is submitted that there is inordinate delay in lodging of FIR, which makes the prosecution case suspicious. In these circumstances, prayer is made to enlarge the applicant on bail.

Learned Panel Lawyer appearing for the State opposed the application for grant of bail and it is submitted by him that direct allegations were made against applicant and he has been named in FIR.

Heard learned counsel for parties.

Investigation in the case is complete and charge-sheet has already been filed. There is delay in lodging of FIR by the prosecutrix. Prosecutrix is a major woman.

Considering aforesaid facts and circumstances of case, bail application filed by applicant is **allowed**. It is directed that the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only)** with one solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court.

In addition to aforesaid condition, the applicant shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C.
