Gambling Act, Section 21 of the Indian Telegraph Act and Section 51(B) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.It is alleged that the applicants were involved in cricket betting operations during the India-England cricket match, which was held on 26th March, 2021 at Ghanuje stadium.

- According to the prosecution, six second of the time lag, between the match and live stream is what helped the bookies keep tab on the movement to accept and even place bets and make money.
- Application for bail, was presented to this Court on 18th May, 2021, where after the State has filed the charge-sheet.
- In view of the changed circumstance, the learned counsel for the applicants seeks leave to withdraw the application with liberty to file an application for bail before

the Court of competent jurisdiction.

- 6 Leave granted. Application is disposed of as withdrawn.
