

4HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE CHEEKATI MANAVENDRANATH ROY**Writ Petition No.1996 of 2021****ORDER:**

The petitioner herein seeks to grant police aid for effective implementation of the *ad interim* injunction order passed in I.A.No.293 of 2019 in O.S.No.288 of 2019 on the file of the Junior Civil Judge, Hindupur.

2). Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for official respondents 1 to 3.

3). Now, it is well-settled law that police aid can be ordered in Writ Petitions only when there is a decree of permanent injunction or when a temporary injunction order was passed on merits after hearing both the parties. It is also settled law that police aid cannot be granted for implementation of the *ad interim* injunction order i.e. *ex parte* interim injunction order passed under Order 39 Rule 3(a) CPC. The impugned order passed in I.A.No.293 of 2019 in O.S.No.288 of 2019 on the file of the Junior Civil Judge, Hindupur, is an *ad interim* injunction order passed under Order 39 Rule 3 CPC. Notices are yet to be served on the respondents therein and they have to file their counter and the petition has to be decided on merits to make the said *ad interim* injunction order absolute.

4). Therefore, this Writ Petition seeking police aid to implement the *ad interim* injunction order is not maintainable under law.

5). Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall also stand closed.
