

**HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE U. DURGA PRASAD RAO
AND
HON'BLE MS. JUSTICE J. UMA DEVI**

WRIT PETITION No.4808 of 2021

ORDER: *(per UDPR,J)*

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief:

“to declare the impugned Notice and Bank attachment dated 5.2.2021 vide DIN No.20200255YL00004ME9E4, issued by the 4th respondent to the 6th respondent Bank demanding to pay a sum of ₹25,92,827/- on account of tax, interest and penalty is payable under the provisions of Central Excise Act, 1944 by the petitioner in spite of pendency of the appeal No-E-30114-2019 EX (DB) challenging the order in appeal of the commissioner (Appeals) before the CESTAT as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently to set aside the said notice and direct the Respondents not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioner pending disposal of appeal before CESTAT and pass such other order as deems fit.”

2. Heard learned counsel for petitioner, Sri K.Raji Reddy, learned Assistant Solicitor General, representing on behalf of 1st respondent and Sri B.V.S.Chalapathi Rao, learned senior standing counsel, representing on behalf of respondents 2 and 3.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner would submit that after filing of this writ petition, the bank attachment was revoked by the respondents and therefore, recording the same, the writ petition may be closed as no further orders are required.

4. Recording the above submission, this writ petition is closed. As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending for consideration, if any, shall stand closed. No costs.
