PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.261 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER: The Court made the following order:-

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) for the respondent.

- 2. The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 & 506(ii) of I.P.C, r/w Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Women Harassment Act, 2002, in Crime No.261 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.
- 3. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous motive, https://hcservices.ecourts.gov.in/hcservices/ the petitioners abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and attacked him by using iron rod. Hence, the complaint.

- 4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.
- 5. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that the first petitioner is having nine previous cases. The Second petitioner is having five previous cases.
 - 6. Considering the antecedents of the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
