Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in

the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Maimpal, when his brother

Mahender Singh was coming on a tractor, he was intercepted by car of the

assailants. When Mahender Singh was stopped, he saw that Vikas (petitioner)

had gripped him, whereas Rahul and one more person gave beatings to him

with rods. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 04

months and 23 days and the complainant as well as victim have filed affidavits

that the petitioner has not caused any injury to him.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated

27.03.2021 in the Court today and has not disputed the factual position.

Learned counsel for the complainant has referred to affidavits of

Mahender Singh, Maimpal and Amit Kumar, victim/complainant/eyewitnesses,

to submit that the petitioner has not caused any such injury.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting

anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and

circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed

to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
