The present Criminal Writ Petition has been preferred by the accused-petitioners praying for the following relief: -

"i) Issue writ order or direction in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the First Information Report No. 0308 of 2020, Under Section 147, 323, 506, of I.P.C., Police Station Transit Camp, District-Udham Singh Nagar."

The writ petition itself is accompanied with a Compounding Application under Section 320 of the Cr.P.C., which has been duly signed by all the parties, including the complainant. Apart from it, the parties to the proceedings have also participated in the hearing, which is being held through Video Conferencing. They have been identified by their respective counsels.

Considering the set of allegations leveled in the F.I.R., as well as the reasons assigned in the Compounding Application, which relates to the commission of the offences under Sections 147, 323 & 506 of the I.P.C., the Compounding Application (I.A. No. 2 of 2021) would stand allowed and, as a consequence thereto, the writ petition would also stand allowed and the F.I.R., being F.I.R. No. 308 of 2020, registered at Police Station Transit Camp, District Udham Singh Nagar, for alleged involvement of the petitioners for the offences under Sections 147, 323 & 506 of the I.P.C. would stand quashed.

Urgency application (I.A. No. 1 of 2021) is, accordingly, disposed of.
