Goyal, Advocate, for the appellant.</p> <p data-bbox="628 613 1490 1093">Appellant has filed a suit for permanent injunction along with an application 6C2 for grant of temporary injunction. Vide impugned order dated 12.4.2021, the prayer of the appellant for grant of temporary injunction has been refused by the court below stating that no orders thereon can be passed without hearing the opposite party.</p> <p data-bbox="628 1144 1490 1877">Learned Counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant is the registered owner of the property, in question, and the electric meter is also installed there in the name of the appellant and he also deposits the water tax in respect of the said property. Learned Counsel further submits that if the temporary injunction is not granted, meanwhile the respondent may dispossess the appellant from the disputed property or alienate the property, in question, or may create any third party interest over there.</p> <p data-bbox="628 1928 1490 2029">Considering the submissions of the learned Counsel for the appellant and the facts</p>
