Khulbe, J.</u></b></p> <p>Mr. Lalit Sharma, learned counsel for the applicant.</p> <p>Mr. Siddhartha Bisht, learned B.H. for the State.</p> <p>Accused–Vikas Chandra has sought his release on bail in connection with Case Crime/FIR No.03 of 2021, u/s 420 IPC, registered at P.S. Satpuli, Distt. Pauri Garhwal.</p> <p>It is fairly argued that there are chances for compromise between the parties; the accused is ready to pay the amount of Rs.6 lakhs to the informant within a period of one month from the date of his release; he is ready to furnish the surety and may be granted bail.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the State fairly submitted that since the accused is ready to pay the entire amount to the aggrieved person, his bail application can be considered.</p> <p>Accordingly, without going into merits of the case, it is a fit case for bail at this stage.</p> <p>Accordingly, bail application is allowed and the applicant is directed to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned with the condition that the accused will pay the amount of Rs.6 lakhs to the informant within a period of one month from the date of his release.</p> <p>Needless to say that, if the accused fails to comply with this order, the State as well as aggrieved person will have a right to move a bail cancellation application before this Court.</p> <p>Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>(R.C.
