**Order**

1. The applicant has filed this bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C in FIR No.219/2021 registered at Police Station Sadar Neemkathana District Sikar for the offences under Sections 188, 269 and 270 IPC and Section 19/54 of the Rajasthan Excise Act.
2. Heard learned counsel for both the sides and perused the material made available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case. The liquor was being sold under the authority of licence. The applicant is not required for the purpose of investigation any more. Learned counsel further submits that in view of recent directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, during pandemic period, the bail application deserves to be allowed.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.

5. Keeping in view all the facts and circumstances of the case, but, without expressing any opinion on merits, the bail application is allowed and it is directed that the accused applicant Vikram Saini S/o Madan Lal be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs.One lac) together with two sureties of the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rs.Fifty Thousand) each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that court and any other court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when he is called upon to do so.

6. A copy of the order be sent to the trial court.
