1. Petitioner has preferred this Criminal Writ Petition (Parole) seeking emergent parole on the ground of demise of his brother.
2. Reply has been filed on behalf of State, wherein they have admitted the fact of death of petitioner's brother.
3. In the report submitted, it is mentioned that neighbours have no objection to the grant of emergent parole to the present petitioner.
4. We have considered the contentions.


5. Taking note of the fact that real brother of petitioner has expired, we deem it proper to grant emergent parole for a period of seven days from the date of release.

6. Criminal Writ Petition (Parole) is accordingly, allowed. Petitioner is directed to release on emergent parole for a period of seven days from the date of release, subject to furnishing his personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- before the concerned Jail Authority and he shall maintain peace and tranquility during the said period and will abide by any other condition imposed by the authority.
