Mr. I. Denning, learned counsel, appears for the petitioner.

Mr. L. Raju, learned counsel, appears for respondent Nos. 1,2, & 3. He states that the order dated 30.11.2021 passed in W.P. (C) No. 469 of 2020 has been duly complied with.

By the order dated 30.11.2021, this Court directed the authorities concerned to consider and dispose of the representation dated 27.05.2019 submitted by the petitioner. It is now stated that order dated 14.03.2022 was issued in compliance with this direction. Though there is delay on the part of the authorities in complying with the order, there is no evidence of such delay being willful or deliberate. This Court is therefore not inclined to take a serious view of the same.

Mr. I. Denning, learned counsel, would however state that the petitioner is not satisfied with the consideration of his earlier representation and

he again made a representation on 26.03.2022. If so, it is left open to him to pursue his remedies.

The contempt case is accordingly closed, subject to the above observation.
