The petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:

(i) Issue notice upon the respondents.

(ii) Call for the relevant records from the custody of the respondents,

(iv) Issue rule calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ shall not be issued for restoration of Khatiyon No.505 & Khatiyon No.435 (prepared based on allotment order dated 27.06.1991 Annexure-4 to this writ petition & allotment order No.19/13 dated 24.07.1986, Annexure-5 to this writ petition which was altered/cancelled by the order dated 24.11.2015 passed by the learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Belonia, South Tripura in violation of directive given by this Hon'ble High Court in its order dated 11.10.2017 passed in PW(C) No.34/2016.

AND/OR

And after hearing the parties be pleased to make the Rule absolute."

During the course of argument, learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted the counter-affidavit and placed on record. The proceeding dated 16.03.2022 wherein, the concerned SDM has directed the Deputy Collector and Magistrate Belonia Revenue Circle for information and necessary action. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the said proceedings which have been issued on 16.03.2022 the order passed therein, would suffice the relief sought for in the present writ petition and according nothing needs to be adjudicated.

In view of above, the present writ petition stands disposed of directing the respondents to consider the order passed on 16.03.2022 and comply with the same as expeditiously as possible.
