- 1. Heard Mr. P.K. Borah, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. H.L. Shangreiso, learned Sr. counsel for the respondent.
- 2. This is an application for restoration of Crl.Rev.P. No. 1 of 2021 which was dismissed for default on 02.12.2021.
- 3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on the date when this matter was posted before this Court i.e. on 02.12.2021, he was at his home town at Nagaon, Assam at the height of the pandemic and COVID-19 restriction and as such, could not travel to come to Shillong. It is also submitted that another petitioner's counsel who was also in the case was at Delhi, could not appear on the date when this matter was fixed. The absence of the learned counsels for the petitioner is not wilful, but for the reasons stated above, it is prayed that for ends of justice, this application may be

- 6. Registry is directed to list the main petition for hearing after 2(two) weeks.
- 7. Crl.M.C. No. 28 of 2022 stands disposed of.
