ORDER

Heard Mr. A. Baruah, learned counsel for the applicant-writ petitioner and Mr. P. Nayak, learned Standing Counsel, GMC.

When the writ petition, W.P.[C] no. 2605/2022 was moved on 08.04.2022, an interim order was passed. The said interim order was extended on the two subsequent dates, 28.04.2022 and 27.05.2022, when the writ petition was listed on 16.06.2022, the writ petition

was ordered to be listed on 20.07.2022. It is stated by the learned counsel for the parties that inadvertently the interim order was not extended by the order dated 16.06.2022.

The present interlocutory application has been preferred by the applicant-writ petitioner seeking extension of the interim order dated 08.04.2022 passed earlier in the writ petition, W.P.[C] no. 2605/2022.

Having regard to the submission of the learned counsel for the parties that inadvertently the interim order was not extended on 16.06.2022, this interlocutory application seeking extension of the interim order dated 08.04.2022 passed in the connected writ petition, W.P.[C] no. 2605/2022 is allowed.
