Heard Mr. S. Das, learned counsel for the applicant.

By this application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963, the applicant has prayed for condonation of delay of 13 days in preferring the connected appeal.

Mr. S. Das, learned counsel for the applicant, submits that the impugned order, dated 08.09.2022, passed by the learned Commissioner employee's Compensation, Lakhimpur, North Lakhimpur in EC Case No. 1/2022 was passed without giving any opportunity of hearing to the applicant, which is cited as one of the grounds in the memo of the connected appeal.
