Heard Mr. S. Munir, learned counsel representing the petitioners as well as Mr. B. Sarma, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam.

By this application filed under Section 439 CrPC, the petitioners, namely, (1) Aminul Rahman and (2) Nur Alom Hussain have prayed for release on bail in connection with Bilasipara P.S. Case No. 363/2022 under Sections 13, 14 and 15 of the Assam Game and Betting Act, 1970.

On the day of occurrence, teer ticket books along with other related articles were recovered from the possession of the present petitioners. Now, they have completed 29 days in custody.

Having heard the learned counsels for both the sides, this court is of the opinion that under the given circumstances of the case the petitioners do not deserve to be detained in custody for further period of time. Hence, the prayer of the petitioners for releasing on bail is allowed.

Accordingly, the petitioners, Aminul Rahman and Nur Alom Hussain who were arrested in connection with Bilasipara P.S. Case No. 363/2022 under Sections 13, 14 and 15 of the Assam Game and Betting Act, 1970 are allowed to go on bail of Rs.20,000/- each with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM (M), Bilasipara.

The bail application is disposed of.
