ORDER 25.02.2022

Petitioners' claim that they are working on consolidated salary basis and are entitled to the benefit of SRO 460 of 2017 dated 26.10.2017 read with the Government Order No. 27-F of 2018 dated 25<sup>th</sup> January 2018, according to which the petitioners are entitled to receive the minimum wages of Rs. 225 per day. The prayer made is that the case of the petitioners be considered for payment of minimum wages in terms of the aforementioned orders.

Considered the limited nature of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to determine the eligibility of the petitioners on touchstone of SRO 460 of 2017 dated 26.10.2017 read with Government Order No. 27-F of 2018 dated 25<sup>th</sup> January 2018. Necessary orders be passed within a period of six weeks and payments be made accordingly.
