ORDER

On the last date of hearing, Medical report of the petitioner was placed on record by the learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said report, the petitioner is stated to be suffering from serious disability and is unable to move without assistance of the attendant. The said Medical report has been verified by the respondent.

Having regard to the nature of the ailment with which the petitioner is suffering and keeping in view his precarious health condition, this petition is disposed of by providing that the temporary bail granted to the petitioner in terms of order dated 30.04.2020, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Bandipora, that has been extended from time to time including by this Court also, shall remain in force for a for further period of six months. Upon expiring of the aforesaid period, in case the condition of the petitioner does not improve, he may approach the learned Trial court for seeking extension of bail on Medical grounds by making an appropriate motion before the said court.
