Petitioner has been made an accused in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No.09 of 2022, registered under Sections 379 and 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(ii) of the Coal Mines Act and Section 21 of the M.M.D.R. Act and 13 of the Jharkhand Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining Transportation and Storage) Rule, 2017, pending in the Court of learned C.J.M., Latehar.

Petitioner is the driver of truck which was seized by police, carrying 25 tons of illegal coal.

It was submitted that petitioner was transporting seized coal at the instance of the owner of the truck.

Petitioner is in custody since 12.01.2022.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of this case, the petitioner named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Latehar, in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No.09 of 2022.
