Heard the parties.

Apprehending their arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.36 of 2021 instituted under Sections 323, 498-A, 377, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act and Section 3/4 of Prevention of Witch (Daain) Practices Act, the petitioners have moved this Court for grant of privileges of anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that the petitioners respectively being the married sister-in-law (*Nanad*), brother-in-law (*Nanadosi*), sister-in-law (*Nanad*) and brother-in-law (*Nanadosi*) of the informant, have treated the informant with cruelty in connection with demand of dowry. It is submitted that the allegations against the petitioners are all false and general and omnibus in nature. It is next submitted that the main allegation is against the husband of the informant. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners undertake to co-operate with the investigation of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioners be given the privileges of anticipatory bail.

Learned Addl.P.P appearing for the State being assisted by the learned counsel for the informant vehemently oppose the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

Considering the submissions of learned counsels and the facts and circumstances stated above, I am inclined to grant privileges of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the petitioners are directed to surrender in the

Court of learned C.J.M., Lohardaga within six weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrendering, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Lohardaga in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.36 of 2021 **with the condition that they will co-operate with the investigation of the case and appear before the investigating officer as and when noticed by him and furnish their mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that they will not change their mobile number during the pendency of the case** and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
