05/21.10.2022 The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the tender notice issued by the respondent No.5 vide memo No. 659 dated 18.02.2022 (Annexure-1 to the writ petition) and rescheduled for 28.03.2022 by publishing notice in the newspaper dated 22.03.2022 (Annexure-2 to the writ petition) whereby settlement by open bidding has been invited for (a) toll collection from vehicles at Bundu Motor Stand (b) Bundu Cattle Sale & Purchase Market and (c) Bundu Road Market & Bajrang Dal Sabji Bazar, as till date no proper site and place for Bundu Motor Stand and Bundu Cattle Market has either been specified or allotted by the respondent authorities.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the nature of the prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition, this Court is of the view that instead of entertaining this case on merit, the petitioner should file a fresh representation before the respondent No.5 requesting him for earmarking proper places for Bundu Motor Stand and Bundu Cattle Sale & Purchase Market.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to prefer a fresh representation on the present issue before the respondent No.5. On receipt of such representation, the respondent No.5, after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as other concerned

persons, shall take an appropriate informed decision within two months from the date of filing of the said representation.
